Through the Week

- Head to the fridge and look at any pictures of family members or people outside your family.
- Remove the magnets, and watch the pictures fall.
- Talk about how magnets prevent the pictures from falling down, but without the magnets the pictures fall.
- Compare how having God in our lives is like having magnets on your fridge.
- If you don't already have a picture of each person in your household, get pictures and use magnets to hold them up. People can also write prayer requests and hold them up with magnets.
- Put all the pictures and prayer requests near the bottom of the fridge.
- Throughout the week, pray for the people and prayer requests on the fridge. When you pray for someone, move that picture or note up higher.
