

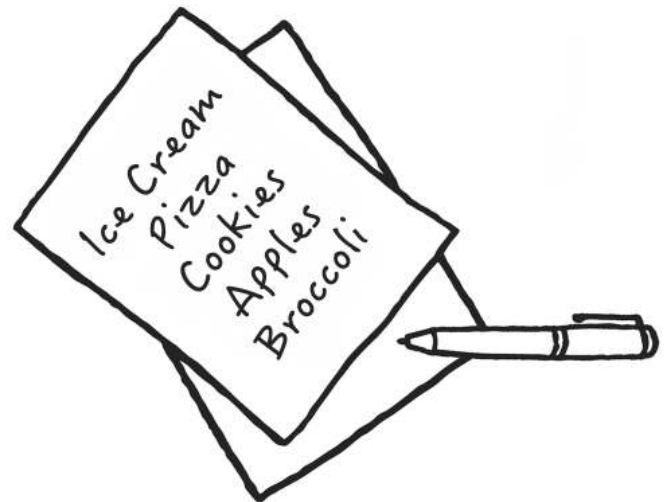

Family Together Time

- Have each person list these sports in order from favorite to least favorite: basketball, baseball, soccer, hockey, football.
- Have each person list these vacation spots in order from where they'd most like to go to where they'd least like to go: Hawaii, Australia, Japan, Italy, Mexico.
- Compare lists to see how each person prioritized things differently.
- Talk about how even though we have different preferences and priorities, what we all have in common is that Jesus is most important.
